DO IT - WEEKLY ACTIVITY

Next, here is a quick activity to do with someone in your family

MIRROR MESS UP

WHAT YOU NEED: Piece of mirror, red & black washable markers.

WHAT YOU DO:

In today's lesson, we learned that God's grace is a free gift. There is no amount of money that you can pay to get it. There is no amount of good things you can do to earn it. The only thing that can wash our sins away is believing in Jesus. We're going to do an activity that will help us think about that. Place a small mirror on the table. Ask your child for examples of different sins that they might commit. For each sin that is shared, use the permanent marker to color a small circle on the mirror. When done allow your child to hold the mirror and look into it. It will appear as though they have spots on their face.

THINK ABOUT IT:

When you look into the mirror, you see what Naaman must have seen. But instead of leprosy, the spots you see are caused by sin. Sometimes people think they can get rid of their sin by being really good. But the sin won't go away. Sometimes people think they can get rid of their sin by giving lots of money to the church or poor people. But the sin still won't go away. There is only one thing that can wash away our sins. Hold up the red marker. Tell the kids that the red reminds us of Jesus' blood. Tell them the only thing that can wash away our sins is believing that Jesus died for us and rose again. Use the marker to colour over the top of the black marker, making it disappear. Allow your kids to colour over the remaining "sin" spots. When all of the spots have been coloured over, wipe over the mirror with the paper towel or cloth. All of the marker will wipe away so that the mirror is clean again.

Read this verse:

"God's grace has saved you because of your faith in Christ. Your salvation doesn't come from anything you do. It is God's gift." Ephesians 2:8

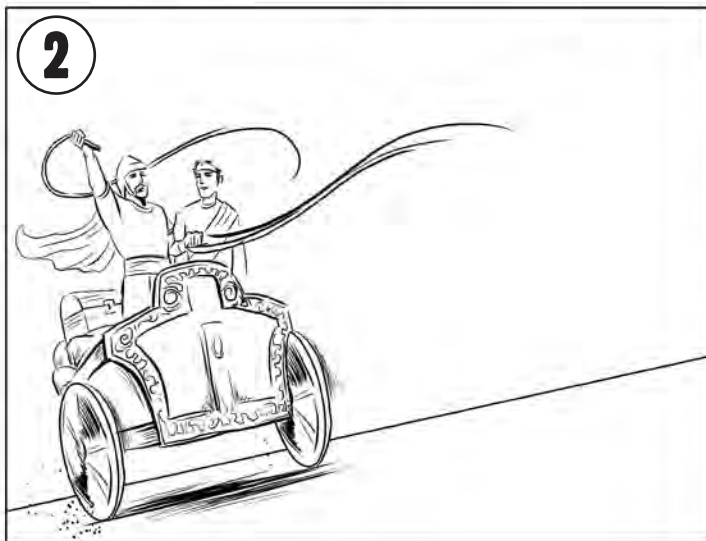
